Kathleen Biggins is the founder and president of C-Change Conversations, a nonprofit organization dedicated to opening minds and building consensus about the changing climate. A non-partisan, science-based organization, C-Change Conversations bridges the political divide as it educates audiences throughout the country about how climate change will impact them personally, why there is urgency to address it, and how to forge consensus for action. Through in-person presentations, online communications, and interviews with topic experts, the organization works to shift the perception of climate change from a political issue to a human one.

The C-Change Primer, a presentation Kathleen began providing in 2017, is the organization’s leading effort to provide an accessible overview of the science behind climate change and a clear-eyed assessment of the potential risks ahead. To date, the Primer has been presented to almost 19,000 people in 32 states across the country. Widely hailed as an intelligent, dispassionate introduction to and illumination of climate change, the Primer has been endorsed by business, political, and social leaders and enthusiastically received by audiences across the country.
